Kingsford Legal Centre (KLC) is a community legal centre.

KLC gives free legal advice to people who live in New South Wales on discrimination problems.

What is discrimination?

Discrimination happens when someone treats you unfairly, for a reason the law says is not allowed.

This is usually because of a characteristic you have. You can't be treated unfairly because of:

- > Your gender
- > Your race
- > Your sexuality
- > Your disability
- > Pregnancy
- > Caring or family responsibilities
- > Transgender status
- > Your age

Discrimination law is complex and covers lots of characteristics. Not all unfair treatment is discrimination.
